

TERMS & CONDITIONS
INTERNATIONAL SPORTS CONVENTION VIRTUAL WEEK 2020

1. Definitions

- 1.1. **"INTERNATIONAL SPORTS CONVENTION VIRTUAL WEEK 2020", "ISC VIRTUAL WEEK 2020", "Event"** – an online event in a digital form, consisting of 6 individual online sports conferences, taking place on December 7-11, 2020. Names and subjects of the above sports Conferences can be a subject to change by the Organiser.
- 1.2. **"Organiser"** – means Sports Development Marketing UK Ltd., based in United Kingdom, WC2H 9JQ London, 71-75 Shelton Street, Covent Garden or – in case of any legal transformation – any other legal entity being the successor of Sports Development Marketing UK Ltd. after such a transformation.
- 1.3. **"Delegate"** – means an individual, signing up to take part in the online sports Conference(s), in a passive manner, under these Terms and Conditions;
- 1.4. **"Participant"** – any other participant of the Event, whether a speaker, partner, sponsor, or other supporter eligible for other benefits in relation to the Event, often provided in Packages.
- 1.5. **"Conference"** – means one of the 6 online sports conferences run under the Event, to take place separately on a particular day;

2. Registrations

- 2.1. Due to limited places all applications to register for the Event are subject to availability and required payment. Priority can be given to individuals designated by the Organiser, partners, sponsors and speakers of the Event.
- 2.2. Applications are to be filled by designated online system (link).
- 2.3. Upon online application and full legitimate payment a confirmation (or rejection) of your registration shall be sent to Delegate's given e-mail address. Upon registration a registration an access code is sent to a Participant with a relevant link to the platform whereon the Event will be broadcast.
- 2.4. Payments are accepted only by credit card, unless otherwise agreed between the Organiser and a Participant.
- 2.5. Once payment is made there are no refunds to be made.
- 2.6. Should a Delegate not be able to participate in the Event or its part, he/she may transfer his/her access (by sending over the link to the Event platform and the access code to another person upon prior written notification sent to the Organiser.
- 2.7. Prices are available on the Event designated online system and may be subject to change.

3. Intellectual Property Rights

- 3.1. All rights related to all presentations, documentation and materials published or otherwise made available as part of the Event (including but not limited to any documentation packs or audio or audio-visual recordings) are owned by us or are included with the permission of the owner of the rights.
- 3.2. No permission is given to any recordings, republications, broadcasts or other processing of the content. Participants shall not distribute, reproduce, modify, store, transfer or in any other way use any of the content, and in particular (but without limitation) shall not upload any content into any shared system, include any content in a database, a website or on any intranet, transmit, re-circulate or otherwise make available any content to anyone else, shall not make any commercial use of the content whatsoever or use content in any way that might infringe third party rights or that may bring us or any of our affiliates into disrepute.

4. Liability

- 4.1. The Organiser shall take no responsibility for the Content and any liabilities, costs, claims, damages, losses and/or expenses arising from any inaccuracy or omission in the Content or arising from any infringing, defamatory or otherwise unlawful material in the Content are hereby excluded to the fullest extent in accordance with the law.
- 4.2. The Organiser shall not be liable to anyone for any loss of profit, loss of or damage to data, loss of anticipated savings or interest, loss of or damage to reputation or goodwill or any indirect, special or consequential damages, loss, costs, claims or expenses of any kind.

5. Data Protection

These Terms and Conditions shall not create, nor shall they be construed as creating, any partnership or agency relationship between the Organiser and Participant.
- 6.2. Participants accept that communication with us may be electronic. Organiser may contact Participants by e-mail or provide them with information by posting notices on Event website. Participants agree to this electronic means of communication and you acknowledge that all such communications that we provide to Participants electronically comply with any legal or contractual requirement that such communication be made in writing.
- 6.3. These Terms and Conditions and the rights and obligations of both parties shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of England and Wales and both Participants irrevocably agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales in respect of any dispute which arises hereunder.
